The Sustainable Enterprise Cluster was created by the Institute for Environmental Entrepreneurship, which continues to manage it.

Participants share space where they can interact, learn from each other, and benefit from the active community of 30 organizations in the Brower Center.

**Rental spaces are \$600/month.** Workspaces are grouped along the walls, to maximize shared space with movable furniture. High speed Wifi, and free use of a black and white laser printer is included, along with access to color printing/copying. Cluster members have use of a conference room and access to the Brower Center's tremendous amenities.
